Why Telemedicine Rocks

Telemedicine is a unique program that.....

- Incorporates education and technology with healthcare.
- Allows patients to be seen from a distance without having to visit the doctor's office.
- Uses technology such as computers and the Internet to communicate with patients.

Features of the Telemedicine Program at Chester Park Complex



Students can be seen while at school

A doctor can check the status of a student's condition remotely from a computer screen.



Send prescriptions remotely

Prescriptions are sent to the pharmacy where parents can pick them up on their own time.



 Doctors can perform a check-up and tests

The doctor can listen to a student's heart and lungs, see the ears and throat and test for the Flu and Strep.



Saves money and time

Students don't need to leave school to see a doctor and parents don't have to be present for the telemedicine visit.
