TIME FOR ANNUAL PHYSICALS AND WELL VISITS

1 SCHOOLS REQUIRE PHYSICALS EACH YEAR

The CDC states that your child's yearly exam keeps he/she up-to-date on vaccines to protect against serious diseases. Protecting your child's health as well as the health of classmates, friends and others in the community is top priority for doctors and school administrators.

2 THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA SCHOOL VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS:

The best time to schedule an appointment for your child's annual physical is during the summer months, well before school begins in August. You want to make sure he/she is healthy to start the new school year. In addition, vaccination reports will be required for your child to begin the academic year.

HOW CAN I PREPARE MY CHILD FOR HIS OR HER YEARLY PHYSICAL?

Prepare your child for a yearly physical by giving the child a quick overview of what will take place. Also, explain which immunizations may be given at that particular appointment. You want to minimize the unexpected and set the stage for a calm appointment.

BRING TO YOUR CHILD'S APPOINTMENT:

- Changes in family medical history.
- Changes in the child's health since the last physical.
- List of any over-the-counter medications the child is taking.
- Your family insurance card.
