


Leading Causes of Premature Death Before Age 75, by Race/Ethnicity








Population Living Below the Poverty Line




Top Community Health Concerns


Population Living Below the Poverty Line, by Age




Top Factors for a Healthy Community









Dental Care in the Past Year Among Adults



Percent







Health Care Insurance Among Adults, by Sex







Mothers who Initiated Prenatal Care in the First Trimester Percent




First Trimester Prenatal Care Entry, by Race/Ethnicity Percent





Breastfeeding Initiation at Birth





Breastfeeding Initiation, by Race/Ethnicity of the Mother Percent

Teen Birth Rate, by Race/Ethnicity














Preterm Birth, by Race/Ethnicity

















Adults with Diabetes, by Race/Ethnicity Percent







New Cases of Cancer Among Females, Lancaster County Rate per 100,000 females




New Cases of Female Breast Cancer, by Race/Ethnicity Rate per 100,000 females



New Cases of Prostate Cancer, by Race/Ethnicity Rate per 100,000 males





Confirmed Cases of Hepatitis A




People Living with Hepatitis C, by Sex


People Living with Hepatitis C Rate per 100,000 population

Rate per 100,000 population





New Chlamydia Infections, by Race/Ethnicity (Incidence) Rate per 100,000 population





People living with HIV/AIDS (Prevalence), by Race/Ethnicity Rate per 100,000 population










Naloxone Administration for Opioid Overdose


Drug Overdose DeathsRate per 100,000 population



Alcohol-Related Emergency Department Visits, by Race






Current Cigarette Smoking



Adults Who Experienced 14 or More Poor Mental Health Days in the Past Month




Adults Who Experienced 14 or More Poor Mental Health Days in the Past Month, by Education






Depression Among Adults, by Sex











Rate per 100,000 population






Heat-Related Injuries






