





Improving Social Determinants of Health—Getting Further Faster (Year 2)

Overview of Training and Technical Assistance Coordination Center Offerings

[Mathematica](#)'s training and technical assistance (TTA) Coordination Center offers a suite of activities to strengthen the capacity and sustainability of multisector community coalitions and partnerships during Year 2 of the Improving Social Determinants of Health (SDOH)-Getting Further Faster (GFF) initiative. This document describes the types of TTA available (Table 1) and includes a schedule of TTA activities. Mathematica's TTA approach is grounded in equity and encourages a culture of collaboration and iterative participatory learning. Based on the findings of the Year 1 post-TTA assessment, and needs expressed in funding applications, Mathematica will proactively and responsively support coalitions and partnerships addressing SDOH by focusing on the following topics:

- Action and sustainability planning
- Policy development
- Assessment and evaluation
- Data use and management
- Communication
- Quality improvement
- Health equity

 <p>Virtual TTA workshops</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Seven monthly 60-to-90-minute hands-on workshops featuring a mix of didactic, interactive learning and peer learning pods (breakout groups), and a combination of facilitated discussion and virtual collaboration tools to support peer learning • Peer learning pods may be assigned based on topics of shared interest, TTA need, or capacity • Three of the seven virtual workshops will be part of a larger Community of Practice that will be open to funded and nonfunded coalitions/partnerships • One closeout webinar
 <p>1:1 TTA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each coalition/partnership will work with a dedicated two-person coaching team for monthly individualized 1:1 TTA focused on the coalitions'/partnerships' goals, progress, challenges, evolving TTA needs, and unique community context • During initial meetings, coaches and coalitions/partnerships will jointly complete Mathematica's TTA Plan Template to identify their TTA goals and support TTA planning • Coaches and coalitions/partnerships will collaborate during regularly scheduled meetings every other month and email check-ins during the interim months
 <p>TTA resources</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mathematica will regularly post existing tools and resources related to the TTA topics listed above to NACCHO's Virtual Community site. These resources will complement the content covered during virtual events and 1:1 TTA. • Mathematica will develop two SDOH-specific resources to support coalitions'/partnerships' policy and sustainability planning: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – A Policy Plan Template and Guide – A Sustainability Plan Template and Guide
 <p>Assessment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coalitions/partnerships will complete pre- and post-TTA assessments to share their knowledge, skills, capacities, and level of need related to the TTA priority topics • One representative from each coalition/partnership will complete these online survey assessments based on group input from other coalition/partnership members
